### TIME OF YESUS VISITATION TO HIS PEOPLE

*“Rejoice greatly daughter of Zion, shout O daughter of Jerusalem. Behold your king is coming to you, He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey”. (Zechariah 9:9).*

#### **JAH Keeps Silent**

Before this prophecy was fulfilled by Yesus, there was a gap of more than 400 years between the end of the Old Testament and the beginning of the New Testament, during which time JAH did not speak in Israel and He did not appear to be involved their affairs. This included the Maccabean period, and during the succession of empires; Persian, Greek, Egyptian and Syrian. By the time Yesus was born, Israel was under Roman occupation and there was no longer a seed of David occupying the throne, but instead, a descendant of Esau, the one called Herod. (St Matthew 2:1-2).

#### **JAH Speaks With a New Testament**


Now was the time of blessing where this prophecy was to be fulfilled with a new testament of God. This new testament opens with JAH speaking to Israel through the prophet, John the Baptist, who prophesied of the Holy One’s coming (St Mark 1:1-8).

#### **Yesus Sealed and Anointed of God to fulfil His purpose as “The Kristos” (Christ)**

*“It came to pass in those days that Yesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptised by John in the Jordan”. (St Mark 1:9).*

Yesus the Son of God, the Anointed One of JAH, ministered to Israel for approximately three and a half years after His baptism, preaching:

*“...the time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand”. (St Mark 1:15)*



#### **Prophecy Fulfilled ~ The Visitation**

In the last glory (week) of Yesus’ life testimony, He entered Jerusalem as was prophesied by Zechariah. With His descent from the Mount of Olives, “riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey”, the multitude of believers rejoiced, crying out:

*“Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He Who comes in the name of the LORD! Hosanna in the highest!”. (St Matthew 21:9).*

*“ ‘Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!’*

*Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!” (St Luke 19:38)*

### JUDGEMENT OF THE UNBELIEVERS

#### The Unbelievers Judged for Not Believing His Visitation

And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples." But He answered and said to them, *"I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."* (St Luke 19:39-40)

Yesus prophesied to the inhabitants of Jerusalem of their destruction for not believing in Him:

*"... "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. For days will come upon you when your enemies build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, and level you and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."* (Luke 19:42-44).

### THE SIEGE OF JERUSALEM ~ PROPHECY FULFILLED

The siege of Jerusalem happened in the year 70 CE. The Roman army captured the city of Jerusalem and destroyed both the city and its Temple. The Roman army, led by the future Emperor Titus, with Tiberius Julius Alexander as his second-in-command, besieged and conquered the city of Jerusalem. The siege of the city began on 14 April 70 CE, three days before the beginning of Passover that year

The siege lasted for about five months; it ended in August 70 CE on Tisha B'Av with the burning and destruction of the Second Temple. The Romans then entered and sacked the Lower City.

#### Destruction of Jerusalem

Josephus, the Jewish historian who acted as a mediator, claims that 1.1 million people were killed during the siege, of which a majority were Jewish. Josephus attributes this to the celebration of Passover which he uses as rationale for the vast number of people present among the death toll. The revolt had not deterred pilgrims from Jewish diaspora communities from trekking to Jerusalem to visit the Temple at Passover, and a large number became trapped in the city and perished during the siege. Armed rebels, as well as the frail citizens, were put to death. All of Jerusalem's remaining citizens became Roman prisoners.

After the Romans killed the armed and elder people, 97,000 were still enslaved, including Simon bar Giora and John of Giscala. Of the 97,000, thousands were forced to become gladiators and eventually expired in the arena. Many others were forced to assist in the building of the Forum of Peace and the Colosseum. Those under 17 years of age were sold into servitude.

Titus and his soldiers celebrated victory upon their return to Rome by parading the Menorah and Table of the Bread of God's Presence through the streets. Up until this parading, these items had only ever been seen by the High Priest of the Temple. This event was memorialized in the Arch of Titus. **Titus reportedly refused to accept a wreath of victory, saying that the victory did not come through his own efforts but that he had merely served as an instrument of divine wrath.**
